

Dear Room 11 Parents,

I look forward to spending time with each of you to dialogue about your child's progress. Just a reminder that the children are released at 1:45 pm every day for the next two weeks. Also, there will be no enrichment classes afterschool at Park. Please let me know of any special arrangements with pickup. Thanks!

Monday afternoon, you will find the homework packet for November, along with the Scholastic Books order form. The two math games for this month are Make Ten and Five-In-A-Row. You will also find a word scramble game with directions to spell words by putting together the letters, which your child will cut out. This activity will reinforce sounds, blends, word families, spelling and vocabulary. Have fun!

At home this month, please continue to play these and any math games that reinforce combinations of numbers up to 10. Knowing these combinations for addition and subtraction up to 10 without using fingers is a target skill for 2nd grade. The homework games are on my website for practice at home: Make 10, Roll & Record Addition, Five-In-A-Row Addition, Heads & Tails, etc.

We are now moving into addition past 10 and up to 20. The students need to develop a knowledge base of combinations to 10 to be most successful. We will also begin to formally teach subtraction strategies up to 10.

Also, please continue to drill doubles at home, particularly past 5 + 5. The students need to know their doubles equations and recall them quickly and with mastery. For example: 7 + 7, 8 + 8, etc. Doubles is an important strategy for getting past 10 into the next decade. The related strategy is "near doubles", for example: 6+7 (same as 6+6+1).
