We are also practicing "first time listening" to directions and following them. This takes a lot of practice, too! Start with one thing, something like cleaning up each time after playing with toys, coming to dinner, being ready when time to leave for school, etc. Thank you!

Don't forget to send an **apple to school on Thursday** morning this week! Any kind will do, but if possible, your child's favorite! We will do some math and science activities with it. Then, we'll eat it! We are studying the life cycle of an apple from seed to fruit. You will soon see your child's work on the hallway wall – hopefully first thing next week!
