










Academic Performance District-Wide







Assessments: ELs take the ELPAC exam to measure progress towards Eng-lish language proficiency. The ELPAC has 4 levels.





Accountability: The 4 ELPAC levels were divided into 6 ELPI levels to determine whether ELs made progress toward English language proficiency.

- Other actions shifted in order in LCAP; no changes to content or budgets
- Communication & Input:
 → Jun 7 LCAP PAC Meeting
 → Jun 12 LCAP Public Hearing
 → Jun 20 LCAP Board approval

Additional Edits to LCAP in Fall

MCOE Technical review (summer)
→ Sep 9 Board approval

Key changes:

- Addressing expense duplication related to 2 new actions
- Funding designations
- Placement of funding in document
