

Low-Performing Students Block Grant

Grant parameters and purpose

- State education initiative
- Serves low-performing students who are not eligible for LCFF supplemental grant funding or special education services
 (Not English Learners, low-income students, foster youth, or students receiving special education services)
- 132,394 allotted to MVSD
- Funds to be spent by Nov 2021
- Used for evidence-based services that directly support student academic achievement (PD, instructional materials, other supports)
- Aligns with our LCAP goals



Low-Performing Students Block Grant



Our Plan

- Professional development to support implementation if standardsaligned curricular and effective instructional practices (\$80,000)
- Instructional materials to support effective academic and character education/social-emotional learning programs (\$52,394)

Measurable Outcomes

- Staff participation in PD and application of their learning
- Student performance on local/standardized assessments
- Student climate survey results, suspension and attendance data
- Student and staff feedback









Categories of questions

- School connectedness
- Caring relationships
- High expectations
- Academic motivation
- Perceived safety at school
- Verbal harassment/violence
- Alcohol, drug, tobacco use
- Other physical and mental health risk factors


