- d. School site council single plan for student achievement, LCAP tied to strategic plan, 1) academic related goal and 2) interventions federal money is spent on Lindsey Caruso. Chelsea and Ryan offered help with this. 1st meeting will be after Feb 26th and before April 1st. Need 3 certificated staff, 1 classified staff and 1 administrator and equal number of parents.
