9. School Board Report - Leslie Wachtel

a. Back to basic aid district, an additional 50 children registered the first week of school, enrollment is flat or slightly down. As this is currently the 5th year of the district strategic plan implementation they have started planning for the next one with 20 focus groups happening starting in October. The LCAP will work with the strategic plan. Next Thursday is a board meeting. October board meeting is at Park at 4:00. A new survey will be sent out in the fall.

10. Presentation by Zero Waste Marin - Casey Poldino

a. Zero waste started 2 years ago, mostly it is food that is wasted. MVSD is trying to be certified "zero waste." The program was implemented last year at Old Mill, Edna and Strawberry is going through it this year. 3 bin system of garbage, compost and recycling to be implemented on campus. It was noted that the proximity to Alto Field and all of the non-Edna events that happen there may cause difficulties as much of the trash on campus is generated by non- Edna events.
