Dear Parent or Guardian:

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 requires that all schools provide parents or guardians of students with annual written notification of expected pesticide use on school sites during the year. The District makes every attempt to resolve pest and weed issues without the use of pesticides and herbicides.

Mill Valley Parks and Recreation Department:

The City of Mill Valley Parks and Recreation Department maintains the fields adjacent to Edna Maguire and Mill Valley Middle Schools, we are providing you with information on the pesticides it may use. Although rarely used, if necessary, the City would schedule application over school breaks when the fields are closed.
